## FIRST YA DYSTOPIAN NOVEL FROM CBA HOUSE RELEASES FANTASY PRODIGY AMANDA L. DAVIS PENS *PRECISELY TERMINATED*

(Chattanooga, TN) Amanda L. Davis isn't your typical 20-year-old. As a teen, she attended writers conferences with her dad, best-selling fantasy novelist Bryan Davis. Despite her dyslexia, Amanda dedicated herself to the writing craft and listened carefully in numerous writers conference workshops. Bryan encouraged his daughter in her writing endeavors, incorporating them into her homeschool curriculum.

Amanda's efforts resulted in *Precisely Terminated*, the first young adult dystopian novel to come from a CBA publishing house. It hits store shelves October 15 from the Living Ink Books imprint of AMG Publishers.

*The story:* Monica, a noble disguised as a slave girl, escaped the chip implantation process that the slaves of Cantral and Cillineese were subjected to at birth. As a result, she alone holds the ability to find a paper bearing instructions for shutting down the mind-controlling computers and execute the paper's directives. But the Cillineese rulers discover Monica's existence and move to seal the city. They plan to gas all the inhabitants before Monica can set them free. The ensuing race against time pits one girl against the tyranny of powerful nobles...with an entire city's inhabitants hanging in the balance.
